Property allowance

The first £1000 you receive in rent from your tenants is taxfree.

The Rent a Room scheme

Earn up to £7,500 a year tax-free from letting out part of your main home.

Replacement of domestic items relief

You can claim tax relief on anything you spend replacing items such as beds, fridges, and sofas.

Allowable expenses

You can deduct expenses that are solely for the purpose of renting out the property.


